

# NELA HES Algorithm – OPCS Codes (Updated June 2019 – updates highlighted in blue in the document)

The following OPCS codes indicate procedures **potentially valid** as an emergency laparotomy if they are the OPCS code for the first emergency operative procedure during the admission.

### Key

- 1. The these procedures occur as part of a repair of any type of hernia; the hernia repair meets the inclusion criteria (NB they are also eligible as procedures in their own right)
- 2. This procedure meets the inclusion criteria for stoma formation if the procedure was not laparoscopic (Y75 procedures) if associated with obstruction (including volvulus, adhesions, malignancy), peritonitis, diverticulitis or fistulae
- 3. If this procedure (freeing of adhesions) occurs as part of a repair of an incisional hernia, it meets the inclusion criteria.

# The following codes are not considered to be an emergency laparotomy if performed as a follow-up to an initial procedure that was ineligible

- T36 Operations on omentum eg omentectomy, biopsy of lesion of omentum
- T411 Other open operations on peritoneum: Open biopsy of lesion of peritoneum NEC
- T418 Other open operations on peritoneum: Other specified
- T419 Other open operations on peritoneum: Unspecified

#### Not all of these procedures are considered eligible for NELA (see Inclusion/Exclusion criteria)

Any procedure is considered ineligible if any of the ICD-10 diagnosis codes (what becomes diag\_01-diag\_20 in HES) for the episode of care are refer to a diagnosis of appendicitis listed below

- K35 Acute appendicitis
- K36 Other appendicitis
- K37 Unspecified appendicitis
- K38 Other diseases of appendix

Or if the main diagnosis code (what becomes diag\_01 in HES) for the episode of care is classified under one of the following groups of ICD-10 codes (see page 4):

- Ascites
- Ineligible Cancer in an elective admission only
- Obs & Gynae

(Previously eligible if the first procedure involved resection/incision of the bowel)

- AAA/Aortic dissection
- Liver conditions

- Male
- Pancreatic disease
- Renal disease
- Trauma

(Previously eligible as a re-operation to an ineligible procedure)

Or it is one of the OPCS listed below when performed under the following treating speciality codes: 501 (Obstetrics), 502 (Gynaecology), 503 (Gynaecological oncology):

- L703 LIGATION OF ARTERY NEC
- T28 OTHER REPAIR OF ANTERIOR ABDOMINAL WALL
- T30 OPENING OF ABDOMEN
- T34 OPEN DRAINAGE OF PERITONEUM
- T36 OPERATIONS ON OMENTUM
- T41 OTHER OPEN OPERATIONS ON PERITONEUM
- T42 THERAPEUTIC ENDOSCOPIC OPERATIONS ON PERITONEUM
- T463 IRRIGATION OF PERITONEAL CAVITY

(Previously eligible as a re-operation to an ineligible procedure)

The HES admission method is used to classify whether a procedure is emergency or elective.

## Ineligible ICD-10 codes

Ascites: R18

Ineligible Cancer: C21 - C25, C261, C51 - C55, C57, C60 - C62, C64 - C68, D30, D41, D73

Obs & Gynae: Relevant ICD-10 codes beginning with N; Any ICD-10 code beginning with O

**AAA/Aortic dissection:** 171, 172, 1790

Liver conditions: K70 - K77, R16 - R17

Male: N40 - N51

Pancreatic disease: K85, K86

**Renal disease:** N00 – N39, N990, N991, N995, N998, N999

**Trauma:** Any ICD-10 code beginning with S except S31, S35, S36
